APPROVED SCHEME OF SERVICE FOR COMPUTER PROFESSIONAL CADRE

The National Council on Establishments (NCE), at its 31st meeting held from 27th November-1st December, 2006 in Asaba, Delta State approved the creation of computer Engineer Cadre in the Schemes of Service structured on GL. 08-17 for graduates and the redesignation of the Data processing officer (Intermediate) and the Programmer Analyst

Cadres as Programme Officer (SGL 06-14) and Programme/System Analyst Cadres (SGL 08 to 17) respectively. This is with a view to align their nomenclatures with current global practices and also in realisation of the expansion of job contents of the cadres.

2. The structure of the Computer Engineer Cadre is as follows:-
