### **CPN IN THE NEWS**

- 1. Computer Professionals (Registration Council of Nigeria) [CPN] submitted a memo to the 9th General Meeting of the National Council on Communications and Digital Economy (NCCDE) on the setting up of a Committee that will look into the feasibility and requirements for the creation of National Digital Education Architecture (NDEAr). The prayers of the memo were approved by the Council.
- 2. The President/Chairman of Council represented Council at the Multi-Stakeholders Sensitization Workshop on the Implementation of Nigeria's National Cybersecurity Policy and Strategy 2021 organized by the Office of the National Security Adviser (ONSA) held on November 16th - 17th 2021 at Oriental Hotel, Victoria Island, Lagos.
- 3. CPN Council holds its 98th Regular Online Council meeting on Wednesday 1st December, 2021. At the meeting, Council took far reaching decisions on wide range of issues that are of immense benefits to registered members and to the IT profession in Nigeria.
- 4. CPN represented the Federal Ministry of Education at the Public Hearing on The Chartered Institute Of

Computer Forensic Of Nigeria Bill 2021 hosted by the House Committee on Science and Technology at the National Assembly Complex, Abuia. Position Paper, CPN opposed the Bill to of functions avoid duplicity confusion among computer professionals and the general public.

- 5. Council also presented a Position paper at the Public Hearing by the Lagos State House of Assembly on Data Protection Bill. In its Position Paper, Council gave far reaching suggestion on how the Protection Bill could Data strengthened so that it can yield maximum value to the people.
- 6. The Computer **Professional** Examination (CPE) was held at Centres across the nation from Wednesday 3rd - Saturday 6th November, 2021. Also the CPE was held for students of Computing at the Kwara University, Malete Tuesday 9th - Friday 12th November, 2021
- 7. The President/Chairman of Council, Mr. Kole Jagun has set up a sub-Committee to consider and advice on aspects of the CPN Act to be reviewed. The CPN enabling Act has been not been reviewed since 1993 when it was established.



The 14th Governing Council of the University of Jos has approved the appointment of a new Vice-Chancellor for the University.


He is Professor Tanko Ishaya who is currently the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Acadamic), University of Jos.

### **ABOUT CPN**

Computer Professionals (Registration Council of Nigeria) [CPN] was established by Act No 49 of 1993. The Act was passed into law on 10th of June and gazetted on the 9th of August that year. It is a corporate entity that is charged with the regulation, control and supervision of the computing profession and practice in Nigeria in line with Section 1 (2) of the Act. CPN is under the supervision of the Federal Ministry of Education.

The Act made it mandatory for all who are engage in the practice of computing in Nigeria to register with the Council. Specifically, the Act provides exclusively for the practice and provision of computer services only to registered members as stipulated under the Act.

The functions and responsibilities of CPN include, but are not limited to the following:-

- 1. To determine the standards of knowledge and skills to be attained by persons seeking to become members of the computing profession and improve those standards from time to time as circumstances may permit.
- 2. To secure, in accordance with the provision of the Act, the establishment and maintenance of a register of persons seeking to be registered under the Act to practice the computing profession and the publication from time to time of the list of such persons.

By Act 49 of 1993, referred to above, it has become mandatory for all persons and organizations seeking to engage, or already engaged, in the sale and/or use of computing facilities, and in the provision of professional services in computing or related computing machinery in Nigeria, to be registered by the Council and licensed to carry out such activities. It is illegal to engage in computing and professional practice without satisfying the above condition -that is, registration and possession of a current valid license.
