GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL ELECTIVE POSITIONS:

- 1. Must be a Member of the Society and a fully registered by CPN for a minimum of 3 years.
- 2. Must have attended two NCS Conferences and one CPN IT Professionals' Assembly within the last 3 years.
- 3. No interested candidate can hold a position for more than 2 terms consecutively.
- 4. Must be paying annual dues at both NCS as at when due and CPN yearly in the last 3 years. Hence, must be a paid-up member at both NCS and CPN
